



Brother John Parker Lee Hopkins, 80, Brother John Parker Lee Hopkins, 80, a Briggittine Monk of the Order of the Most Holy Savior, has gone to his rest in the arms of the Lord, May 14, 2018.

He was born to Littleton Roberts Hopkins and Blanche Patricia Whithorne on June 8, 1937 in Logan, West Virginia.

A graduate of Xavier University, Cincinnati, Ohio, he entered the religious life with the Briggittine Monks who were then in Fresno, California on July 7, 1977, (a year after the foundation of the community) and professed his solemn vows on July 23, 1991.

There will be a vigil for him on May 18, 2018, Friday, at The Briggittine Monastery at 23300 SW Walker Lane, Amity and a Funeral Mass on May 19, 2018, the next day, Saturday, at 10:00 o'clock a.m. The Most Reverend John G. Vlazny, Archbishop Emeritus of the Archdiocese of Portland in Oregon will be presiding.
